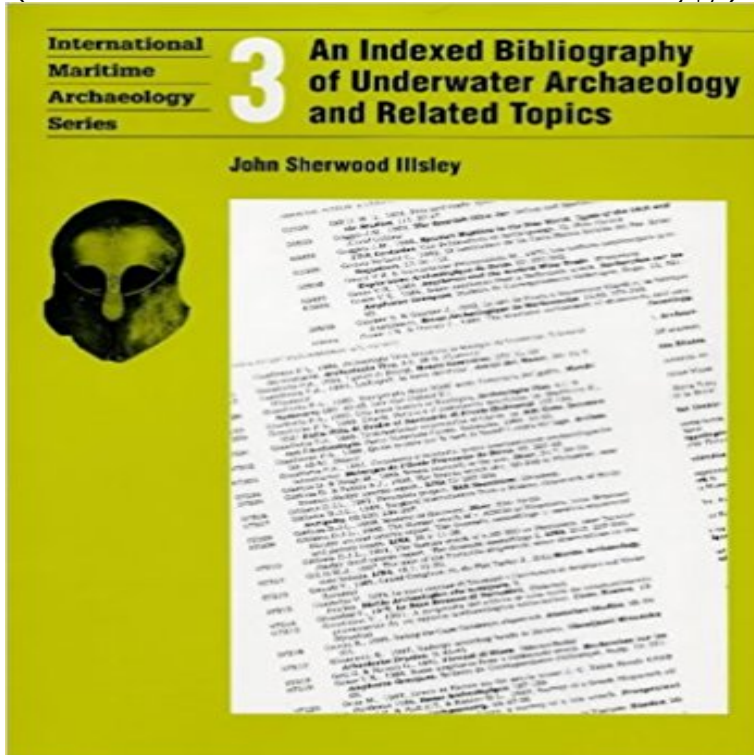


# Bibliography of Underwater Archaeology and Related Subjects (International Maritime Archaeology)



The exponential growth in underwater excavations makes this non selective bibliography an essential resource. It brings together more than 12,000 citations compiled from periodical notes in the International Journal of Underwater Archaeology and from other references, footnotes and bibliographies from associated disciplines. Citations are subdivided into broad subject areas for browsing: General Guides and Background Works; Shipbuilding and Naval Architecture; Underwater Archaeology; Artefacts; Conservation; Archaeological Sites: Historical Background and Site Reports and Miscellaneous Topics.
